

Founded in 1987, the Asian Youth Orchestra (AYO) is a highly competitive six-week tuition free summer music program for musicians from 17 to 27 years old. Each year, auditions are held throughout the Asian region for the 100 or so musicians eager for a place in AYO. These talented musicians, most on track to become professionals in the world's leading orchestras, come together for a three week intensive Rehearsal Camp, coached by an exceptional artist-faculty of principal players from internationally renowned orchestras, and three week concert tour, performing with major international solo artists, under the direction of AYO's Artistic Director and Founder Mr. Richard Pontzious, and AYO's Guest Conductor Joseph Bastian.

2019 marks AYO's 29th season. AYO will continue to expand its annual program to create a "Hong Kong Music Summer Orchestra" which is designed especially for 100 or more* local talented students from 12 to 22 years old for a special performance on 4 August.

Members of the HKMSO will also participate in free workshops and master classes coached by AYO's international artist-faculty and AYO distinguished alumni.
